Saint Patrick's Day, observed annually on March 17, is a global celebration of Irish culture. St. Patrick's Day is Ireland's biggest holiday. However, the clergyman it celebrates was not Irish. Maewyn Succat, as he was then called, was born in modern-day England in 387 AD. He was kidnapped and brought to work on sheep farms in Ireland at age 16. The teenager escaped a few years later and spent 15 years at a monastery in England. Over the next few centuries, he was credited with heroic deeds, including driving out all snakes from Ireland. The March 17 celebration started in 1631 when the Church established a Feast Day in honor of St. Patrick.
